The numbers in this report reflect many, but not all, of the accomplishments and services provided by the Health Department to help prevent the spread of communicable diseases, promote positive health behaviors, reduce poor health risks and provide for a safe, clean and healthy environment.

During Fiscal Year 2008-2009, with the collaboration of our staff and many of our community organizations and citizens, and despite budgetary constraints, we have made several accomplishments: introduced a more comprehensive environmental health reporting feature to our website, handled a major Hepatitis C outbreak, enhanced family planning outreach through a new initiative, created a new Health Department and Clinical Services brochure, implemented a new physical activity/nutrition program for adult women, and began to address Novel H1N1 Virus.

Healthy Carolinians continues to work towards a healthier community on priorities focusing on heart disease, diabetes, hypertension, physical activity and nutrition through several new and creative initiatives.

I would like to thank the Health Department staff, the Board of Health, the County Manager and the County Commissioners for their commitment in addressing public health issues. I also want to encourage and challenge the citizens of Scotland County to embrace positive health behaviors and lifestyles to become a healthier community.
